Thank you for getting your seedlings from Natick Community Organic Farm! We grow certified-organic seedlings from untreated, nonGMO, and mostly organic seeds that have been selected for performance and reliability in our climate. (Nonorganic plants are labeled as such.) Seedlings are planted in a homemade soil mix that provides our plants with the nutrients that they need to develop strong roots and stems. Perennials by Jayne, a local grower, are raised according to organic practices.

- Minimum order is \$25. If you are short, please consider buddying up with a friend.
