



AmeriCorps Service Member Position with TerraCorps & Natick Community Organic Farm

TerraCorps is a nonprofit organization working at the intersection of land conservation, sustainable farming, and local food systems to build local nonprofit capacity while growing the next generation of emerging leaders committed to making a difference at the community level. We value the power of local nonprofits to best understand and serve their communities, and our goal is to help them succeed by providing them access to the AmeriCorps national service model to build organizational capacity.

TerraCorps partners with a network of nonprofits in Massachusetts and Rhode Island focused on community needs related to local land conservation and sustainable agriculture. These partners act as service sites for a new cohort of AmeriCorps service members annually. Service members are paired with a site supervisor who provides guidance and mentorship while they learn to manage community programs and projects over a 1,700-hour service term. **The 2026–27 service year runs September 8, 2026, to July 30, 2027.**



Natick Community Organic Farm is interviewing candidates for a Youth Education Coordinator (YEC). The YEC will engage with the Assistant Director, Education to manage volunteers on community service projects, educate or train individuals in environmental stewardship or environmentally conscious practices, and complete three capacity building projects.

Potential projects include:

- Serve collaboratively with the Farm's Assistant Director of Education and Schools, Scout, and Volunteer Coordinator to expand and deliver drop-in educational programming for homeschool families, helping meet the growing community demand for hands-on, family-centered learning experiences through partnerships with local homeschool groups and co-ops.
- Support and expand farm education programs that engage more than 3,500 children annually through field trips, camps, and public programming by providing hands-on learning experiences focused on sustainability, food systems, and environmental stewardship while helping develop, evaluate, and refine curriculum that responds to growing community demand.
- Collaborate with and help manage volunteers through the farm's summer Leader in Training program and monthly teen volunteer service days, supporting youth leadership development while engaging volunteers in environmental education, animal care, gardening, composting, harvesting, and other farm stewardship activities.
